

For the December 24, 2020 COVID-19 positive test report, we have five new Nursing Facility residents test positive for COVID-19 and we have not had three or more residents or staff with new onset of respiratory symptoms occurring within 72 hours of each other. Three new cases occurred on an existing Red Zone, Villa Elizabeth, and two new cases occurred on Villa David Courtyard. All other residents in the Nursing Facility have tested negative for COVID-19 during this recent round of weekly testing of the nursing facility residents.

Therefore, cumulatively to date since March 2020 we have a total of:

We continue to take the necessary infection prevention and control measures to limit potential exposures which includes, but is not limited to, contact tracing, testing the residents and staff, creating cohorting zones and wearing appropriate Personal Protective Equipment as per the Pennsylvania Department of Health and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services guidance. St. Anne Home has been scheduled to have an onsite COVID-19 vaccination clinic, conducted and scheduled through a collaboration with Walgreens and PharMerica Pharmacies, for residents and staff on clinic on January 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
