For the December 29, 2020 COVID-19 positive test report, we have one new Nursing Facility Staff member test positive for COVID-19 and we have not had three or more residents or staff with new onset of respiratory symptoms occurring within 72 hours of each other. Through contact tracing and a risk assessment for this Nursing Facility Staff member it was determined that the they did not have any prolonged close contact with any residents or staff during their potential infectious period.

Therefore, cumulatively to date since March 2020 we have a total of:

We continue to take the necessary infection prevention and control measures to limit potential exposures which includes, but is not limited to, contact tracing, testing the residents and staff, creating cohorting zones and wearing appropriate Personal Protective Equipment as per the Pennsylvania Department of Health and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services guidance. St. Anne Home has been scheduled to have an onsite COVID-19 vaccination clinic, conducted and scheduled through a collaboration with Walgreens and PharMerica Pharmacies, for residents and staff on clinic on January 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
