Dear Visitors of Residents,

To help support visitor and resident safety, the CDC recently provided additional recommendations for visitor communications to be posted at the entrances of all Long-Term Care Facilities. Please take note of the three CDC posters, which are posted at our visitor entrance titled:

- Getting 'Back to Normal' Is Going to Take **All** of Our Tools
- Getting a COVID-19 vaccine adds one more layer of protection
- Cover your Cough

These serve as helpful reminders to protect yourself and the residents living at St. Anne Home.

Please do not visit residents or enter the building if you have **any** of the following:

- A positive viral test for SARS-Cov-2 (COVID-19)
- Symptoms of COVID-19, (can include but are not limited to fever, new dizziness, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, difficulty breathing, chills, body aches)
- If you currently meet the criteria for **quarantine**. Quarantine is when you might have been exposed to the virus. You **isolate** when you have been infected with the virus, even if you don't have symptoms.

Visitors should only visit the resident's room and should minimize their time spent in other locations in the facility. Once in the building, as our standard procedure and practice has been, you will be asked additional screening questions that must be answered and documented upon entrance and exit of the building.
